Dutch Supercar Challenge/ Mosler Challenge season opener at Silverstone - this sequence of shots from the start of the second race of the day which saw an incident just before the start line that eliminated three of the six Moslers present.

As David Lord's shots below show, Kevin Riley's red car spun and struck the pit wall which set off the predictable chain reaction which also took out of the running the MT900Rs of Berry van Elk and Paul White, the Moore Racing International car veering to the outside in avoidance but digging in the new gravel trap and flipping over.
